

What is WGHC's Management Committee?



The Management Committee is made up of a maximum of 15 members of West Granton Housing Co-operative.

A chairperson, treasurer and secretary are elected by members at the Annual General Meeting.

The Management Committee is responsible for ensuring WGHC operates on a proper financial and legal footing. It has ultimate control over all aspects of the organisations work and is accountable to all the members of the organisation.

The Co-operative employs staff who deal with all the administration and day to day running of WGHC, which means that the Committee is not involved in dealing with individual tenants.

What is expected of members?

Management Committee members receive clear guidelines from a Policy & Procedures Documents Pack which sets out how WGHC operates. They must adhere to the Code of Conduct and declare any conflicts of interest relating to matters arising.

The Committee meets approximately 10 times in a year. Meetings are usually held once a month, beginning at 7.00pm and lasting about an hour.

An agenda, minutes from the previous meeting and reports are sent out to Committee members before the meeting. Members are then able to contribute to discussions and decision making during the meetings.



The Management Committee may also decide to form subcommittees. It may also decide to establish ad hoc subcommittees to perform specific tasks within a specific time; for example to review a particular policy or procedure.

What do I get in return for being a Committee Member?

- ⇒ The opportunity to gain new skills and knowledge through attending training courses, and representing WGHC at conferences;
- ⇒ The opportunity to have a personal input into the decision making of the co-operative;
- ⇒ The opportunity to influence change within the community;
- ⇒ Childcare expenses and expenses for attending conferences or training sessions;
- ⇒ The chance to make new friends and contacts in the community.

How to apply to join the Management Committee

Co-opted committee membership

Any member who is interested can apply to be co-opted onto the Committee. Being co-opted means that no election takes place but that your application to join is approved by the existing members of the Committee. You will be invited to attend a Committee Meeting and you will be asked to confirm that you wish to take on the responsibility of being a committee member.

Full committee membership

Every year an Annual General Meeting is held. A pack is sent to all members inviting them to attend. At this time any member can apply to stand for the Management Committee by filling in a nomination form and being seconded by another member. If more members stand than there are vacant places then an election is held at the end of the AGM. Those members with the most votes are duly elected.
